INDIVIDUAL & CLASS INSTRUCTION

INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION

The instruction is adapted to the successful development and progress of the individual student. It will be offered in thirty-minute time blocks. Lessons are available for voice, piano, guitar, bass guitar, flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, and tuba. Students are expected to buy instruction books as needed.

CLASS INSTRUCTION

Adult classes are available for keyboard and dance. Dance classes are also available through Dance Quest for children ages 2-5.

REGISTRATION & TUITION

Fill out the attached registration form and bring to your first lesson.

A one time, non-refundable registration fee of \$35.00 must accompany the application. Tuition is payable per session. Half of the session fee is due prior to the first lesson, with the balance due in thirty days. A late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed each 30-day period until the balance is paid in full.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

A 30-day written notice is required if a student wishes to terminate instruction. The student will be financially responsible for lessons that occur within the 30 days from the date notice is given, and a refund will be given for the balance of the semester.

SCHEDULE

Individual lessons are scheduled on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. They begin no earlier than 3:00 PM and conclude no later than 8:00 PM. Students are assigned to instructors based on 1) the date of paid registration, 2) the student's preference of time, and 3) availability of instructors.

Adult ballet and keyboard classes are offered Tuesdays. Dance for ages 2-5 is offered through Dance Quest. For more information and registration visit DanceQuestOnline.com.

MAKE-UP LESSONS

It is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher if a lesson is to be missed. If the teacher cannot be reached, the student should notify the School office, 689-1204, ext. 203. Any lesson missed or cancelled by the instructor is the responsibility of the instructor to make up. Make-up lessons are only granted for an excused absence in which the instructor is notified at least three hours prior to the lesson time. An excused absence is: a) student illness, b) extreme emergency, or c) death in the family. Only two make-up lessons per semester will be offered. No lessons will be made up if they are missed due to late payments (the students will be charged a full semester fee). No make-ups are offered for classes.
